Did you know?



One out of six Oklahomans, or 16.2%, live under the poverty level compared to 14.2% nation- wide. As of October 2012, the unemployment rate in Oklahoma was 5.3%.

The average cost of basic food, supplies, medical care and training for a dog or cat is \$600 to \$900 annually (national average).

Approximately 5 million to 7 million companion animals enter animal shelters nationwide every year, and approximately 3 million to 4 million are euthanized (60% of dogs and 70% of cats).

The cost of taxpayer money annually to round up, house, kill and dispose of homeless animals is \$2 billion nationally. On average it costs \$125 per animal. National average shows half of all shelter intakes are owner surrender.

Isn't a better solution to help keep families and pets together and build a stronger human and animal bond? Teach compassion and responsibility to our children in hopes of a better world for all? Spay/neuter family pets for the pet's well being and reduce the number of unwanted litters and subsequently reduce the number of pets euthanized.
